## **Scientific Research Grant Guidelines**

Please note the following:

1. Applications from individuals will not be considered.
2. If your institution has not submitted a proposal for support of research to the Trust in the last five years, please call Dr. Van Zytveld, Senior Program Director at the Trust (360-694-8415), before completing the Research Application Form.

The Trust has an understanding with all research institutions in our funding region that only requests that are institutional priorities are to be submitted, and that no more than two proposals should be under consideration by the Trust from any institution at any time. These proposals may seek support for research in the natural sciences, for research in engineering, or for research in medicine, but no more than one in any of these three areas may be under consideration at any given time. In this way, requests in any one of these areas should be submitted no more frequently than about once per year. Therefore, the Trust does not accept grant requests from individual researchers unless the institution endorses that request as its priority to the Trust. The authority to provide this endorsement lies with the chief executive officer of the institution or may be delegated to a chief academic or research officer.
